

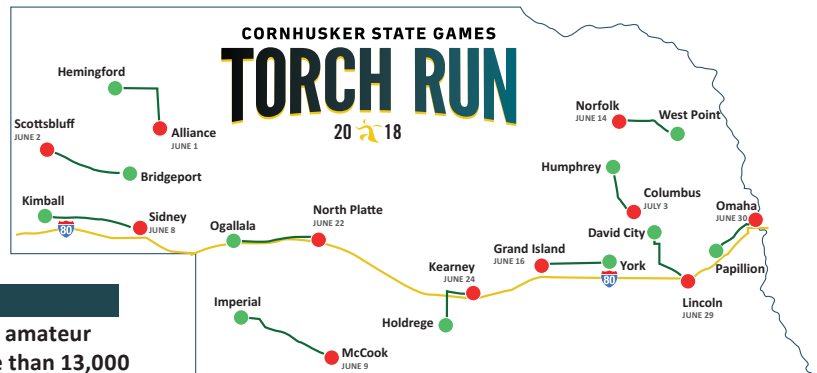

DESCRIPTION

The Cornhusker State Games is one of the largest amateur sports festivals in the nation. On July 21-30, more than 13,000 Nebraskans of all ages and abilities will compete in more than 60 sports, showcasing their talents and encouraging others to adopt healthy, active lifestyles.

The spirit of the Games will be spread statewide by the Torch Run, thanks to the efforts of hundreds of runners and volunteers. Patterned after the Olympic Torch Run, the relay focuses the attention of the public on the Cornhusker State Games as it crosses the state.

RULES

Runners must run at least one mile and may choose the general location during registration. Schedulers will use runners' addresses to make assignments as convenient as possible, unless otherwise directed. Miles will be scheduled according to Nebraska Department of Roads mile marker numbers, on a first-come, first-served basis.

CORNHUSKER STATE GAMES TORCH RUN WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the NEBRASKA SPORTS COUNCIL athletics/sports program, and related events and activities, the undersigned:

- Agrees that prior to participating, he/she will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if he/she believes anything is unsafe, will refuse to participate.
- Acknowledges and fully understands that he/she will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from his/her own actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used.
- Assumes all the foregoing risks and accepts personal responsibility for the damages following such an injury, permanent disability or death.
- Releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue the NEBRASKA SPORTS COUNCIL, its affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releasees", from the demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise.
- Understands the following refund policy: There will be NO refunds of entry fees because of inclement weather or other acts of nature. The only exceptions to the no-refund policy are: Entries received after the entry deadline; Entries of non-qualified entrants; Entries of those prohibited from participating due to errors made by the Nebraska Sports Council; Special circumstances as determined on an individual basis by the Board of Directors and requiring board action. NO REFUNDS WILL BE PERMITTED SIMPLY BECAUSE AN ATHLETE FAILS TO PARTICIPATE.
- Agrees to allow the Nebraska Sports Council to photograph him/her during the Nebraska Sports Council events and to display his/her image in promotion of the Nebraska Sports Council programs including social media sites such as Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Instagram, etc.
- Pledges to adhere to the Nebraska Sports Council standards of sportsmanship and respect opponents, coaches, officials and spectators at all times by not engaging in verbal or physical altercations at any time before, during or after competition.
- Acknowledges that he/she is aware of the Concussion Awareness Law (LB 260) and understands that information is available at www.cdc.gov.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY. THIS FORM WAIVES LIABILITY FOR NEGLIGENCE. THIS AGREEMENT CANNOT BE MODIFIED ORALLY.
