

2018 CSG Outstanding Wrestlers

Ages 8 & Under

Owen Jasper, Columer, Age 8, 59#

Owen won 4 gold and 2 silver Medals. Owen went 16-2 over the weekend with 7 falls and 4 tech falls. He earned his second Iron Man shirt and now has 6 CSG gold medals and two silver medals. He wrestles for the Columbus Wrestling Club.

Ages 9 - 11

Brett Larson, Gothenburg, Age 9, 55#

Brett won 6 gold medals while going 16-0 over the two days. He had 6 falls and 8 tech falls. Brett has won 21 medals in 5 years. Brett has now won 4 straight Iron Man shirts and 14 gold medals. He wrestles for the Gothenburg Swede Wrestling Club. Brett has shown strong skills in all styles at a very early age.

Ages 12 - 14

Adrian Bice, Columbus, Age 14, 94#

Adrian won 6 gold medals while going 11-0 over the weekend. He had 3 falls and 7 tech falls. He earned his second Iron Man shirt. He has 9 gold medals and 3 silver medals. He wrestles for the Columbus Wrestling Organization.

Ages 15 - 17

Lathan Duda, Broken Bow, Age 15, 170#

Lathan won 6 gold medals. Lathan's was 16-0 on weekend with 5 falls and 10 tech falls. He earned his second second Iron Man shirt and now has 10 gold medals. He wrestles for Broken Bow High School.

Ages 18 & Over

Jamaal Bufford, Omaha, Age 27, 205#

Jamaal just wrestled on Sunday and won 2 gold medals. He now has 20 gold medals and 5 silver medals over the past 5 years with a 57-5 record. He is from Houston, Texas and wrestled for Missouri Valley in college.

Female Ages 12 & Under

Maycee Peacher, Omaha, Age 10, 78#

Maycee had a very busy weekend as she entered 5 girls events and 5 boys events taking home nine gold medals and one silver medal. She went 24-1 with 7 falls and 13 tech falls. Her only loss came during the last session in a Takedown match to William Moninger from Arnold. Note that William was two years older. This was her second Iron Man shirt. Maycee wrestles for both NWA and Nebraska Boyz wrestling clubs.

Female Ages 13 & Over

Kiana Major, Platte, SD, Age 13, 124#

Kiana won three gold medals, two silver medals, and one bronze medal. Half of those medals were earned against the boys. She went 10-4 with 2 falls and 4 tech falls. Note that her wrestling is O.J. Kids Wrestling Club in Okinawa, Japan where her mother is station. She is a very sound wrestler and competed well with the guys.
